**** Multiples of 40 plants are preferred as this suits the size of the racks we use in the nursery and makes assembling your order much easier. Minimum order is 120 plants of mixed species. Minimum number of one species is 10 plants.**

**** Prices for tree guards will vary depending on what we pay to our suppliers. 2024 prices are \$100 per box of 250 cartons and \$85 per bale of 500 stakes. Prices may change for 2025 delivery.**

Central Tablelands Landcare Nursery

Central Tablelands Landcare Nursery is located at the Department of Primary Industries Centre, Research Station Drive, Bathurst.

Our nursery grows a range of trees, shrubs, grasses and ground flora from the endangered Box-Gum Woodlands and high-altitude grassy woodlands. The nursery is run as a not for profit program and supports local projects with the supply of local provenance plants. We do not operate as a walk-in retail business.

The nursery is operated by two part-time staff and with assistance from volunteers from the Landcare community.

Terms and conditions for purchase of plants from Central Tablelands Landcare Nursery

1. All species grown in the Nursery are native to the Bathurst – Blayney – Orange – Cabonne Local Government Areas. Seed is sourced from within this area, wherever possible.
2. The Nursery grows plants to order and does not have stock available for walk-in purchase.
3. If the Nursery has stock in excess of contracts, orders will be taken while existing stock lasts. Availability of surplus stock will be advertised through the Central Tablelands Landcare network, usually in late Autumn.
4. Orders for tube stock to be planted in Autumn-Winter (March – June) should be placed before 30th September of the previous year. This allows time for seed to be sown and plants to be grown out to a suitable size for planting. Some species may require longer than 6 - 7 months to grow to a suitable size. **NB Closing date extended to October 31st, ANFD special**
5. Where possible, species should be ordered in multiples of 40. This is the size of the racks we use in the nursery and assists with assembling your order prior to pick-up.
6. All orders must be collected by the end of June or by a date negotiated with the nursery team. We prefer not to hold plants over winter.
7. All purchases must be paid for in full prior to collection from the nursery. You will receive an invoice by email and payment may be made by bank transfer. We do not accept cash. We accept credit card payment (NB Surcharge 1.6%-2.2%).
8. Central Tablelands Landcare Nursery will not be held responsible for loss or damage to plants if they are not collected by the agreed pick-up date.
9. Collection of plants must be pre-arranged with the Nursery Manager as the nursery is not staffed every day.
10. Central Tablelands Landcare Nursery retains the right to sell plants that are not collected by the agreed date, unless an extension is negotiated with the Nursery Manager.
11. Tree guards comprising 2L waxed cardboard cartons and two bamboo stakes per carton are also available for purchase. Prices will vary depending on the price we pay to our supplier.
12. If you require species other than those shown in our list, or if you would like us to grow native plants from seed collected on your own property, please discuss with the Nursery Manager.
